In reference to the subject mentioned above I am directed to inform you that the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the West Bengal State University is pleased to approve the affiliation of new B.Ed college in the name of Adamas Institute of Teacher Education, Vill - Sadarpur, P.O. - Jagannathpur, Barrackpore -1, Barasat, Kolkata, North 24 Parganas. West Bengal, PIN 700126 from 2012-13 academic session.

The affiliated institute is requested to follow the guideline as mentioned below :

01. The approval of affiliation for the said College will be temporary w.e.f. 2012-13 academic session.
02. An amount of Rs.41,000.00/- has to be paid by the college authority to the University as an inspection and affiliation fee against Demand Draft in favour of "West Bengal State University" payable at "Barasat" or "Kolkata".
03. The aforesaid college will be allowed to offer following Methods from the academic session 2012-13 : Bengali, English, Geography, Life Science, Mathematics, Work Education, Education, Physical Education, Fine Arts. History and Physical Science may be provided subject to recruitment of Teachers.
04. The intake capacity will be 100 per batch per year following the guidelines of NCTE.
05. The syllabus of the B.Ed course will be followed as per University norms.
06. The college authority will have to follow the guidelines of the affiliating University, Govt. of West Bengal & NCTE as and when required.
07. Required number of Teaching and Non-teaching employees including Librarian are to be employed before starting the session.
08. Laboratories & Library are to be equipped in consultation with the experts.
09. All future correspondence will be made to the Principal of the said college.
10. The process of admission of students will be done following the guidelines of West Bengal State University.
11. The aforesaid college will be guided by the rules, regulations, statutes and ordinance etc. of West Bengal State University.
12. The University authority will nominate two Nominees in the Management Committee of the college following the guidelines of University.
13. The College Authority is requested to start the classes on and from 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2012 till 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2012 to fulfill the required 90 working days (As per NCTE norms) in which they have to arrange Seven seminars on the topics related to syllabus of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester on six Sundays and on 2<sup>nd</sup> October (Gandhi Birth Day).  
They are requested to follow the fees structure for the students to be admitted in the said programme as follows :  
1<sup>st</sup> Semester Rs.40,000 (with caution Money of five thousand) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Rs.35,000
